At the entrance of each ramp is a trash receptacle. These receptacles are there for the purpose of everyday garbage only. All other large items should be taken to the city garbage dump or check with management to see that large items are disposed of properly.

Dinghies that are not in use also need to be taken out of the water and stored on your vessel.

Please do not place oil in open buckets on the ramp area. The oil bin is located inside fence between Filet's and Office Building. Barrels are there for your recycled oil.

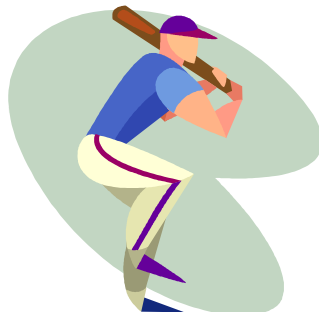
Anita's Recipe Corner
